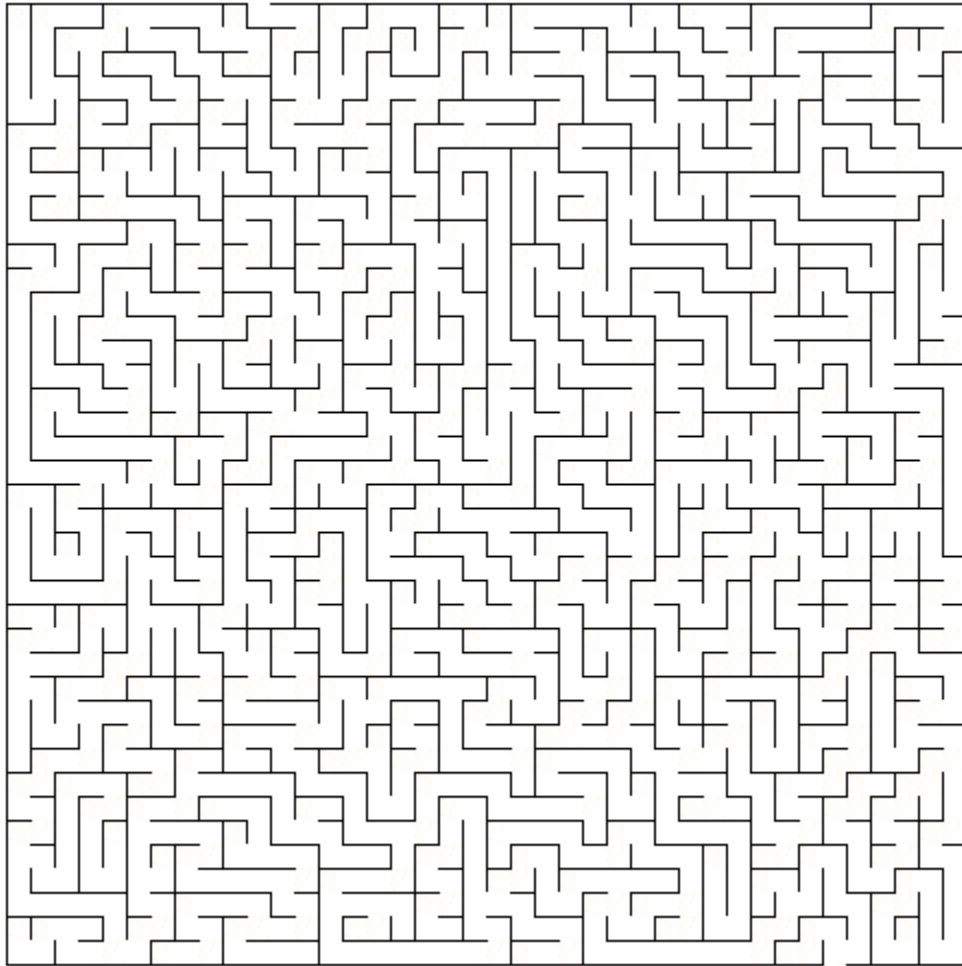


Walking to the Kirtland High School
