CHURCH HISTORIC SITES AND STORIES

Visit Emma Smith's birthplace in Harmony, Pennsylvania, and hear about how her childhood experiences impacted the type of leader she was to become in the early church.

See the historic landscapes and sites in Palmyra, New York, and learn about the first female members of the church. Gain a greater understanding of their role in preparing the first missionaries.

Experience Kirtland, Nauvoo, and Plano through the eyes of the women who lived in these historic communities. Learn about their passion to help those in need and commitment to building community.

Visit Liberty Hall and hear the tales behind the ladies of Lamoni who helped build homes for the orphans and elderly in their community, and made significant contributions towards the founding of Graceland University.
