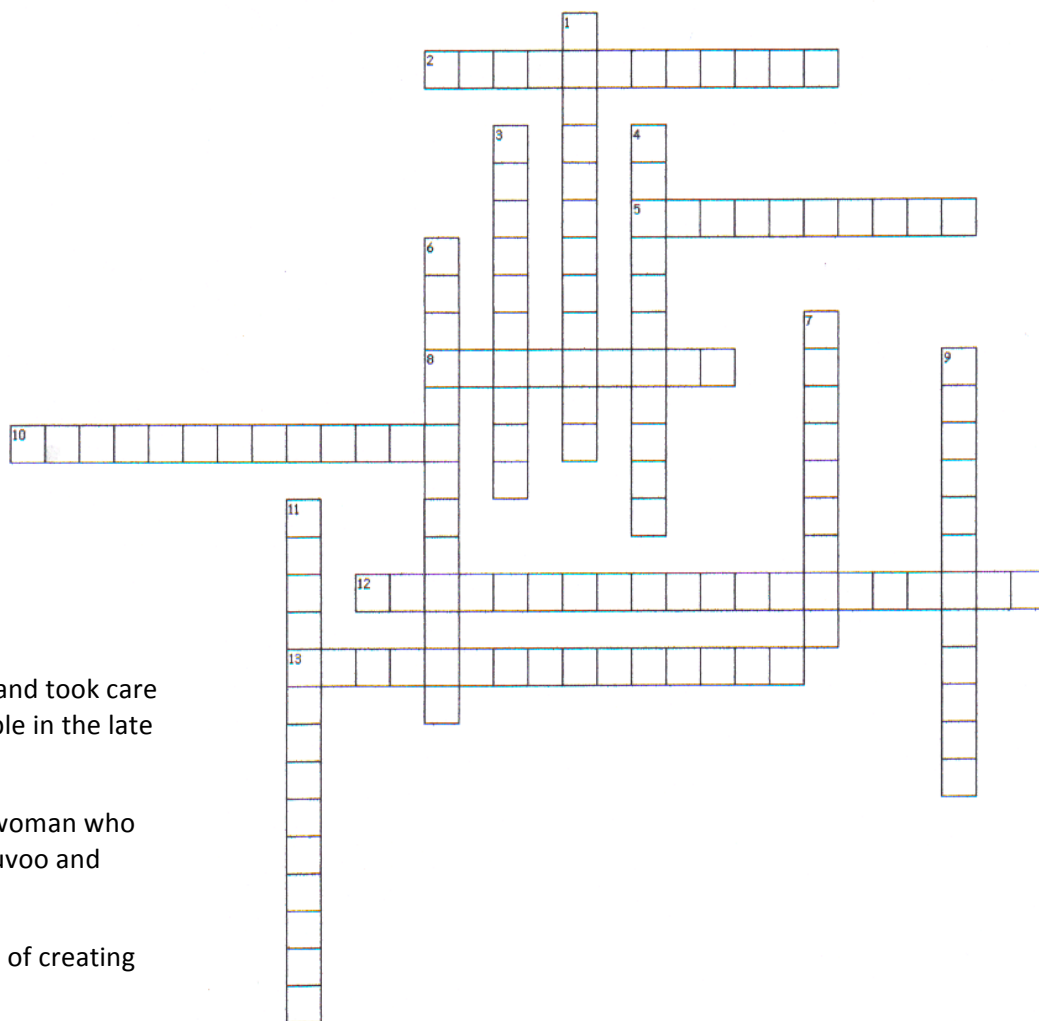


Historic Women of the Community of Christ
